If you have attended SUUSI since 2022, you can get a coupon code by logging into SOLIS and clicking the "Generate a Coupon Code" link. Pass that code on to your friends! REMEMBER TO SIGN UP FOR A VOLUNTEER JOB DURING REGISTRATION

As you register for things to do at SUUSI, please consider a volunteer shift or two. We need you! The SUUSI magic only happens we have volunteers making it so. You can sort by time, interest, age, etc. Volunteering at SUUSI is a great way to meet people and find out how things work. For example, you could be a DJ! (see below)

The volunteer jobs show a priority. "High" means position is needed for activity to occur, "Medium" means it will make the activity easier/better, and "Low" is nice to have, but we can do without if we have to. Please consider High and Medium priority jobs first. THANK YOU for your donation to the SUUSI community!



The Nightlife team is looking for volunteers to DJ at CACHE, SUUSI's Alcohol-free dance space. Teens and Young Adults will be given priority, but we encourage anyone with DJ experience to apply. Please log into your Solis account and go to the webpage for [Volunteer Jobs](#). Then, select the shifts (under CACHE DJs) that you would be able to do.

STAFF POSITIONS STILL OPEN

If you need help affording SUUSI, you can still apply to be on staff. When you log into SOLIS, put in an application. There are still positions available on Nurture or DEI and Accessibility staff, and if you like working with young people, there are positions available with the Youth (ages 0-10), Middlers (11-13) and Teens (14-17) programs.
